Position Summary:

The nurse will provide all nursing care services within the hospital. Specifically, they will provide quality nursing care and support to patients. The care they give will enhance the outcomes for outpatients through education, liaison, case management, co-coordinating the treatment and discharge planning processes.

Main Purpose:

The primary role is to aid the Midwife in taking blood pressure, listening to the baby's heart rate, checking the patient's weight, tracking labour contractions, keeping information needed for the birth certificate, such as the time of birth and helping make the mother comfortable as well as birth spacing counselling and Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF) i.

Priority Task and Responsibilities:

- Provide support in all aspects of midwifery care under the indirect supervision of qualified midwife staff members, assist in assessing the mother and baby during the postnatal care and provide direct care working with mothers within their plan of care
- Be able to plan and prioritize tasks to meet the needs of women and their babies
- Work under own initiative and undertake basic observations on mothers, including Blood Pressure, Temperature, Pulse, Respirations, Urinalysis, Height Measurement and Weight
- Respond to clinical emergencies ensuring patient safety at all times and alerting appropriate staff members promptly
- Assists the Qualified Nurse for diagnosis and treatment of patients with common diseases
- Provides/assists patients for medical care when needed
- Interviews patients to identify their needs and concerns
- Screens patients to support for urgent attentions by nurse/midwife for severe patients;
- Plans/implements and evaluates assigned patients by the nurse
- Cleans equipment and keeps them in order and proper place
- Organizes referral if needed; transports patients on Stretchers, Ambulances and Wheelchairs if necessary and appropriate
- Carries out other assignments given by the duty nurse or in charge nurse in line with his/her job description
- Maintains orderly follow up of patients
- Dispenses medicines properly when required and keeps record properly
- Any other roles as may be assigned by the project manager

- At least 2-year experience working in a recognized health institution/primary health care center or worked with agencies that carry out health activities
