Position Summary:

Responsible for the community outreach services provided within Kahda where AAIN supports one primary health care facility and 2 mobile clinics. The CH Supervisor will constitute and coordinate the full team of the Community Health Workers (14) and will liaise, coordinate and share with other teams (medical) when required.

Priority Task and Responsibilities:

- Offer peer health education and support to families within the designated areas
- Provide health information through community outreach, group health education sessions, individual encounters and home visits to assess patient needs and concerns as they relate to their family, their community and their health
- Plans and leads group health education sessions and discussions on assigned health topics

- Makes referrals to healthcare access and follows up with individuals to ensure they receive needed service
- Plan, organize and participate in health awareness trainings/workshops
- Develop relationships with local healthcare and social service providers to create a robust collaborative network to serve the community needs
- Support and supervise community health workers
- Any other roles as may be assigned by the project manager
